After expenses and honorariums paid including **\$10,000 donated to Kids Are Worth It Nutrition Program** yearly; overall money raised is given back to **children groups and nonprofit groups** that help sell tree tickets for a day.

Impact of the Festival for the Community:

The committee only has the money they raise through tree tickets (\$1.00 each) and the money they get donated, to pay for the expenses and then all the rest is donated back to the community.

TWO different types of cheques are given out by the committee:

1. To organizations that helped put on the event that weekend in some way. These groups receive an honorarium of \$500.00.

2. To local organizations that sell tickets for a day-guaranteed a minimum of \$500.00 and then split the left-over money once all expenses are paid.
